RESULT DECLARATION:-

The academic result of the session 2022-23 will be declared on 16th March 2023 i.e. Saturday. Timings for the PTM will be from 8:00 am to 11:00 am.

COMMENCEMENT OF THE NEW SESSION:-

The new academic session for the school will commence from 20th March 2023 for Std.I to XII onwards. However, for Std.I the new session will start from 1st April 2022. 'The secret to getting ahead is to get started', therefore we look forward to constant cooperation from parents to send their wards to the school from the beginning of the session to build a strong base for the upcoming class. Summer Vacations will begin from 1st May and the school will reopen on 17th June.

SCHOOL TIMINGS:-

REGULARITY & PUNCTUALITY:-

ATTENDANCE:-

As per norms laid down by CBSE, 75% attendance is compulsory for appearing in examinations right from Std. I - XII. The student will not be allowed to sit in the examination if attendance is below 75% without valid reasons.

BOOKS & NOTE-BOOKS:-

A book list is provided along with the sampark for your convenience. **Parents are free to purchase the books & note books from any vendor.** Kindly ensure that your ward brings books from the very start of the academic session to stay at par with the syllabus. Properly covered and well-labelled books not only speak about a student's personality but also increase the book's life. Hence, take care to cover and label them.

UNIFORM DETAILS:-

A significant part of your child's year is spent in the school uniform. Please ensure that you get new pairs of uniform stitched in time since a well fitted, bright uniform adds to the confidence and personality of your ward. Avoid sending your ward in dull, faded and worn-out uniform to the school.

Feel free to buy uniform from any shop of your choice and ensure that the school mono which is provided free from the school, is stitched on it. The uniform, as per detail given below, will be available on display board of the school.

SCHOOL PLANNER:-

Note : All fees, clubbed together, are to be paid quarterly, in advance, by the dates specified for each quarter (April-June, July-September, October-December and January-March). Please refer to the fees card for further details.

Parents are requested to pay fees in time. Late deposit of fees will lead to imposition of fine of Rs. 100/- per month for late deposit, beyond 10th of April, July, October & January. Please ensure collection of receipt and get the entries done in the Fees Card each time you deposit the fees to avoid any confusion. Please refer to the fees rules in the Fees Card for further understanding.

If fees remains in arrears for two quarters, without any valid reason, the name of the student will be struck off & TC will be sent to the parents by post at their recorded address, under prior intimation.

STREAM CHOOSING CHARGES :-

The school incurs extra expenses & its resources are utilized when the student reaches in Std. XI. Therefore, one time charges for choosing particular stream i.e. Science or Commerce, amounting to ₹15,000/- are levied, in addition to other prescribed fees.

CASHLESS TRANSACTION FACILITY:-

Online payments are a convenient way to deposit your ward's school fees in time without much hassle and physical contact. Please deposit quarterly fees and bus fare through online banking.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT:-

The school takes all care to provide safe and convenient transport to all the students. Our buses are equipped with all the facilities including GPRS system, first aid box, fire extinguishers etc. Parents are requested to avail the transport facility provided by the school. The bus fare is very low. The school incurs losses on bus operations. Even then, keeping in view the safe conveyance provided by the school, we have continued this facility.

***Note :** If you wish to avail bus facility in the middle of the session, kindly intimate the school authorities a month in advance. Please refer to the bus rules in the Fees Card for further information.*

RULES FOR SCHOOL BUS USERS:-

- The bus fare shall be payable for all the months except May due to vacations, in advance, along with school fees. Full month's fees is payable even when the facility is availed for a part of that month.
- The buses will pick up the students from allotted bus stops and drop them, after the school hours, at the same stop. The school does not take any responsibility for the child to reach home after he/she is dropped at the allotted bus stop.
- If the student discontinues the facility & wants to re-avail it after some time, during the same academic year, he/she will have to make payment for the gap period also.
- The details of the stoppages mentioned below are fixed ones. Buses do not ply according to individual convenience. If parents change their address after admission, the school will make changes in the bus routes or stoppages as per convenience of the school. It will not be a binding on the school to provide bus facility on change of address of the student.

PRIVATE & OWNED TRANSPORT:-

The school does not take any responsibility for any incident that takes place in private transport. It is mandatory for students who come to school by their own conveyance to wear helmets and carry a valid licence, if they are permitted as per RTO rules.

SAFETY OF THE STUDENT - UNIQUE ID CARD SYSTEM FOR WALKERS:-

School has introduced Unique ID Card System for Walkers. It will carry all the details of your ward along with photograph of the student, father & mother to ensure the safety of the child. If parents are unable to pick up their child from the school, the guardians/relatives authorised by the parents can show that card and take the child on their behalf. But if that card is lost and picked up by a stranger, the school will not own any responsibility. In case of card being lost, the parents will inform the school immediately and get a new one signed by paying a nominal fees of ₹100/-.

EMPHASIS ON SPOKEN ENGLISH:-

English has become a universal language today that links people around the globe and is a vital factor in determining an individual's future trajectory. The language can be inculcated into habit with constant spoken practice. Parents are requested to motivate their wards to converse in English, both in school and at home to build upon fluency & vocabulary and co-operate in the matter as much as possible.

PRIVATE TUITION/ COACHING:-

In school, our teachers diligently pay individual attention to supplement every child's learning curve and provide quality education. We urge parents to talk to the student about school teaching and other activities. The process will not only make you aware of the school's activities and updates but also help you discover your child's hidden talents and interests and strengthen your bond with them. Avoid sending your child for private tuitions which weighs them down with rote learning and kills their inquisitiveness, ultimately defeating the purpose of education. School teaching is enough for learning.

CYBER SAFETY:-

With the onset of the pandemic and increased dependency of education on technology, students spend a significant part of their day online. Apart from the only benefits of convenience and becoming techno-savvy, your ward faces the risk of over-exposure to the e-world which might result in poor social skills and weaker family relations. Besides, there is an added fear of being trapped in cyber crimes and unwanted situations unknowingly. Kindly monitor your child's activities regularly and save her from internet addiction. Now since the intensity of the pandemic has decreased, schools will function as before. Therefore, send your child regularly to the school.

COMMUNICATION FROM TEACHERS:-

Your ward is a part of a Class WhatsApp Group that includes their subject teachers along with their class teacher. The group is used to convey information and communication from the teachers' end regarding examinations taken throughout the year, PTMs, competitions and internal assessments for every subject. The group also features a Monthly Newsletter from the desk of the Principal, discussing the monthly activities of the school. Parents are requested to check the Class WhatsApp group regularly to stay up with all the necessary information.

HOMEWORK/STUDY MATERIAL ON WHATSAPP:-

Your ward is also a part of individual subject groups where homework is sent by the subject teachers daily. Required study material, worksheets and sample papers are also made available before examinations by subject teachers. Kindly check these groups daily so that your child is at par with the course being covered in classes.

ART EDUCATION AND ART INTEGRATED LEARNING

As per the mandatory instructions of CBSE, Art Education and Art Integrated Learning are given to the students to assess Subject Enrichment Skills classroom teaching which are an integral part of the curriculum for classes I to XII. Parents are requested to procure sufficient material required as directed by the concerned teachers for all the subjects throughout the session in advance, if possible, and give us their whole-hearted cooperation.
